EIGHT REASONS TO INVEST IN UZHHOROD

The proximity of the Borders with the **European Union** Uzhhorod is the centre of the Zakarpattia Oblast, bordering four EU countries – Slovakia, Romania, Poland and Hungary. Uzhhorod is the only oblast centre of Ukraine, the boundaries of which coincide with the State border (international checkpoint with Slovakia).





Three European and two international highways, one road of national importance pass through Uzhhorod. The railway station provides transportation of passengers and goods within Ukraine and abroad. There is an airport within the local area as well as suburban, intercity and international buses which depart from the two bus stations.



There are 26 higher and vocational educational institutions operating in the city. The number of male and female students exceeds 22 thousand people, of which one quarter are technical specialists. More than 50% of the city's population has a high level of education.



Access to the city government has been made available online on the official website of the Uzhhorod City Council – «Office of the Uzhhorod City Council» on which information is published about: the budget; property that can be rented or bought through auction: session and executive committee decisions; action plans from the mayor, etc.

Favourable **Business** Climate



The city has a modern Administrative Services Centre which provides almost 300 types of services for the public and businesses. The city government also offers financial assistance to entrepreneurs, tax benefits for investors, all-encompassing support for investment projects, and institutional support for the growth of entrepreneurship.





Rapid Dynamics of Infrastructure and Public Space **Development**



Significant development projects are being implemented in the community from budgets at all levels and with funds from international technical assistance and financial organisations. Among them: reconstruction of stadiums and embankments, capital repairs of educational institutions and hospitals etc.

Uzhhorod City Territorial Community (CTC) was founded on June 12, 2020, in accordance with the order of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine No. 712. The community covers one settlement – **Uzhhorod City,** which also is a regional centre of Zakarpattia Oblast.

Uzhhorod National University is the largest higher education institution in Zakarpattia Oblast. Founded in 1945, The university trains teachers, engineers, doctors, managers, etc. The total number of students is almost 15,000. It has 24 faculties, a Department of Physical Education, a Vocational College and four institutes (Institute of Economics and International Relations, Educational and Scientific Institute of Chemistry and Ecology, Ukrainian-Hungarian Educational and Scientific Institute, Institute of International Partnership). The university includes educational, administrative, economic

and residential premises (dormitories), Communal Non-Profit Enterprise «Andrii Novak Zakarpattia Oblast Clinical Hospital», laboratories, patent department and space research station. Took 12th place in the academic rating of the 200 best educational institutions

In the Uzhhorod City there are:

CONNECTING **TO THE NETWORKS**



Wired Internet services in the city are provided by about 20 companies, the largest of which is Kyivstar. The maximum speed is 500 Mbit/s. The average cost of broadband Internet access is between USD 5-20 per month. 99% of the city is covered by 3G and 4G networks. Mobile Internet services are provided by: 3G/4G - Kyivstar, Lifecell, Vodafone; CDMA -PeopleNet. CTC has an extensive Ukrtelecom wired telephone network. National cellular operators work on the territory of the community (Kyivstar, Lifecell and Vodafone).



ENERGY NETWORKS

The utility company «Vodokanal of Uzhhorod» provides 24-hour centralised water supply and drainage. The total length of water supply networks is 285.9 km, of which 49.7% are old and in disrepair.

The service company is PJSC «Zakarpattiaoblenergo». The city has a developed electrification system and the necessary power reserve (including for connecting consumers with a significant amount of consumption). Power lines with a capacity from 0.4 kV to 220 kV are available.



The service company is PJSC «Zakarpatgaz». The city is completely gas-powered. There are 26 gas distribution stations (GDS) on the territory. The technical throughput capacity of GDS is 86.85 thousand m³/h, the free throughput capacity of GDS is 64.12 thousand m³/h.



The city has an individual heating system. Centralised heating began to be replaced in 2004 by installing autonomous boilers in apartments and houses. Schools, kindergartens, hospitals and administrative buildings are heated by 62 modular boiler houses. Five of them are on alternative fuels. One of the boiler houses heats several medical organisations (maternity hospital, a regional infectious disease hospital and a city hospital, as well as a polyclinic).



The service company is LLC «AVE Uzhhorod». Local government bodies are gradually implementing a modern system of separate collection and processing of solid household waste (SHW). The landfill through which SHW disposal is carried out has a capacity of 1,260 tonnes and is located outside the city in the Barvinok village. Reclamation of the municipal solid waste landfill has been carried out in recent years at the expense of the Uzhhorod City budget (over UAH 15 million).

ECONOMIC POTENTIAL

Uzhhorod CTC is a community with the most powerful economy in Zakarpattia Oblast and the necessary infrastructure for successful business development.

The vast majority of small business entities are engaged in trade and household services. The 85% of private entrepreneurs-individuals are the biggest source of income for the **City Budget.** Income to the City Budget from personal income tax for 9 months of 2022 is UAH 871.4 million, which is UAH 102.8 million more than last year.

LLC «INTERFIL»

The plant produces cosmetic and household goods. The company is part of the industrial holding «Fareva» one of the largest world leaders in the industrial and household, cosmetic and pharmaceutical industries. The «Fareva» group of companies is represented in many European, North American and South American countries, such as France, Germany, Great Britain, Switzerland, Ukraine, Turkey, Italy, Mexico, Brazil, etc. It has more than 10,000 employees.

PE «POLONYNSKYI KHLIB»

A wholesale bakery that produces and sells about 200 types of bakery and confectionery products through its own chain of stores.



RC «UZHHOROD COGNAC **FACTORY**»

It is among the top three producers of local cognacs. The plant's share in the cognac market of Ukraine is about 13%. In 1959, the first batch of brandy was produced and aged in oak barrels. In 2009, new bottling lines for vintage and ordinary cognacs were installed at the enterprise, production facilities were modernised, and new premises for alcohol ageing were built. The collection of cognacs includes eight names: three vintage (Uzhhorod, Karpaty, Tysa) and five ordinary (Five Stars, Zakarpattia, Three Stars, Beskydy, Nevytskyi Castle).



LLC «PLANT «CONVECTOR»

The No. 1 manufacturer of gas convectors in Ukraine. Produces 14 models of AKOG gas convectors of various capacities with cast iron and steel heat exchangers, boilers, water heaters, air ozonisers, mounting cabinets and accessories.

PJSC «UZHHOROD SEWING FACTORY»

Produces high-quality women's clothing - jackets, coats, trousers, shorts, skirts and dresses. The company was founded in 1946 and has been fulfilling orders from EU companies for more than 25 years. Produces clothes for brands in Germany, France, Austria, USA: Weill, Tory Burch, Marc O'Polo, Bogner, Stapf, etc. Services include sampling, template making, sizing, cutting, sewing, pressing, quality inspection and packaging. Monthly capacity - 25 thousand units (20 thousand trousers and 5 thousand jackets). It has its own clothing brand «Parada», an online and offline store.



Construction of the plant began in 1979. The plant's facilities include its own railway track and are designed for 40 automatic production lines and 700 units of various automatic equipment. The plant manufactures AC motors used in everyday life: the drive of a concrete mixer, juicer, food processor, activator of washing machines, drum-type washing machines, household electric sharpener, root cutter, grain crusher, centrifuge, pumps, lawn mowers.

LLC «TURBOHAZ UZHHOROD»

Manufacturer of equipment for the oil industry and mining industry, consumer goods, steel and cast iron. Modern technologies and materials are used in the development of new products, which allow their operation in any climatic conditions from arctic to southern latitudes, as well as at great depths.

BUDGET PROFILE

A high level of budgetary security is a competitive advantage of the Uzhhorod CTC. The funds of the City Budget are enough to finance current expenses. The community also successfully implements projects and measures of social and economic development, so for 2022, financing of such projects in the amount of UAH 115.6 million was provided. In 2023, UAH 409.6 million will be spent from the budget of the Uzhhorod CTC for the implementation of 46 city and oblast programmes. The community budget is a donor budget, which means, it transfers funds to the State Budget of Ukraine through the mechanism of reverse subvention: in 2021, the amount of subvention reached UAH 110.5 million, in 2022 it amounted to UAH 134.1 million, planned for 2023 – UAH 246.4 million. Uzhhorod's budgetary capabilities allow maintaining a **significant level of internal demand** through the purchase of goods, works and services – UAH 577.4 million was the volume of such purchases by the Uzhhorod City Council, its subordinate divisions, enterprises and institutions in 2022. The liquidity of the budget of the Uzhhorod CTC, calculated as the ratio of the average monthly balances of funds in the treasury account to the general fund expenditures for 2022, was 24%.

TOURIST POTENTIAL

The tourism industry is becoming increasingly important for the development of the city's economy. In 2022, the City Budget income from the tourist tax exceeded the figure of 2021 by 3.5 times. Uzhhorod has all the prerequisites for intensive development of domestic and foreign tourism: features of the geographical location and topography, a favourable climate, sufficient human resources, a developed network of transport connections, etc. Additional business potential belongs to the factors described below.

A WIDE NETWORK OF HOTEL INSTITUTIONS

There are more than 50 institutions (hotels, motels, hostels and hotel-tourist complexes) operating in the Uzhhorod City, with the simultaneous possibility of accommodating about 2.5 thousand people.





PICTURESQUE PARKS AND SQUARES

Uzhhorod is a city of park culture. Exotic cherry blossoms, magnolias, yudina trees, platon trees grow in the city avenues, in flowerbeds, along the streets, in the Botanical Garden and in the three most famous parks (Psdzamkovyi, Laudona, Bozdoskyi), and there is a linden alley along the embankment.

LARGE **FESTIVALS**

Every month, the city organises festivals and festive events that last from several days to a week, including: Sakura-Fest (April), Bridal Parade (June), Uzhhorod Regatta (July), City Day (September), Zakarpattia Beaujolais (November), Mykolaychiks Parade (December) and others.



SIGNIFICANT ARCHITECTURAL HERITAGE

City buildings were constructed in various architectural styles from the XI-XII centuries to the present day: Horiansk rotunda - the church of St. Anna (XI century), Uzhhorod Castle (XII-XVIII centuries) – the oldest monument of fortification art and architecture, Khrestovozdvyzhenskui Cathedral (constructed in 1644), Shelestivska Church of St. Mykhailo (built in 1777 without a single nail), Tsegolnianska Church (1802), Oblast Philharmonic Hall former synagogue (1902) and others.



DEVELOPED GASTROCULTURE

The uniqueness of local gastronomy lies in the combination of gastronomic preferences of different nationalities: Ukrainian, Hungarian, Romanian, Slovak, Czech, Polish, Italian, Indian, Arab, Japanese, etc. Uzhhorod is also famous for its special attitude towards coffee consumption. There are more than 100 food establishments in the city, which are rapidly developing a modern culture of food and service. The average check per person is about USD 10-20.







LOW-RATE TOURIST TAX

The tourist tax rate ranges from 0.25% to 0.5%, while the maximum rate according to the Tax Code of Ukraine can reach 5.0%.



DEPOSITS OF MINERAL HEALING AND TABLE WATER

On the territory of the city there are more than 20 displays of mineral waters, natural springs and artificial wells of the Yesentuky, Narzan and Naftusia types.

Uzhhorod ctc is a leader in the development of infrastructure and public spaces in the zakarpattia oblast.









EDUCATION

1. There is a network of all types of educational institutions in the community, from kindergartens to universities:

- 24 preschool educational institutions (19 general development, 1 general development with 24-hour stay, 1 sanatorium type with 24-hour stay,
- 3 combined type); • 27 institutions of general secondary education
- of the communal form of ownership and 3 private;
- 9 vocational and technical education institutions;
- 5 institutions of higher education;
- 12 universities.

CREATION OF LIVING ENVIRONMENT

Between 2016 and 2022, UAH 1.1 billion was invested in the improvement of the city. Parks were repaired (carried out repairs of benches, ramps and pathway, bins were installed, flower beds and children's playgrounds were constructed), inner-quarter territories, city roads, roofs in apartment buildings, street lighting networks, water supply and drainage, as well as replacement of doors and windows in multiapartment buildings

By the decision of Uzhhorod City Council No. 718 on 31 May, 2022 until the end of 2023, the land plots on the territory of the Uzhhorod CTC were exempted from payment of land tax:

- for placement and permanent activity of bodies and subdivisions of the State Emergency Service and the National Guard;
- under the facilities and networks of the centralised water supply and drainage system, which are owned by the city territorial community;
- communal non-commercial enterprises in the field of health care, the founder of which is the Uzhhorod City Council, provided that the volume of paid medical services does not exceed 20% of the volume of all services provided.

By the decision of Uzhhorod City Council No. 786 on 12 July, 2022 until the end of 2023, land plots on the territory of the Uzhhorod CTC were exempted from payment of land tax:

- that are intended for the construction and maintenance of physical culture and sports facilities;
- association of co-owners of an apartment building, house committees, entered in the Register of Non-profit Institutions and Organizations.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- minimum salary UAH 6,700 per month (established on October 1, 2022);
